**Minutes of the Play Park Committee held at 7.00 pm on Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> June**  
**On site at Cerne Abbas Play Park, Duck Street**

**Present:** Cllrs M. Keating, C. Crosbie, and L. Prowse

**1. Appointment of Chair**

Cllr Keating was proposed and seconded and duly elected Chair of the committee.  
It was agreed to annually rotate this appointment.

**2. Apologises for absence**

All members were present.

**3. Declarations of pecuniary and other interests**

**4. To agree the minutes of the previous meeting held on 10<sup>th</sup> October 2019**

These were agreed as a true and accurate record of the meeting.

**5. Chairman's update**

The Chair confirmed all improvements to the playpark since the last meeting. These included:

New cradle swing and bar swing to replace old.  
New basket swing to replace the tyre swing.  
New roundabout in an unused area of the play park.  
Jet wash the multi play.  
Full paint of the multi play.  
New picnic bench.  
Jet wash of most of the benches.  
Full paint of the metals of the benches.  
Securing of the posts in front of the swings.  
Replacement of the shackles on the swings.  
Painting of the frame of the swings.  
Installation of new signage.

**6. Inspection Report and site inspection (remedial items for action)**

It was agreed to replace the shackles and chains on the tyre climber.  
The posts had been secured.

**7. Future projects**

It was agreed to complete the jet washing of the benches.
